REPLACEMENT OF LOST VOTER ID CARDS

The limited biometric voter registration exercise commences on Thursday, 28th April and ends on Sunday, 8th May, 2016. The Electoral Commission takes the opportunity to reiterate to the general public, that the limited registration exercise is for members of the public who have not previously registered.

For registered voters who have misplaced their cards, the Commission has put arrangements in place for replacement of lost voter ID cards in all district offices nationwide.

Applicants would be required to pay a replacement fee of **Five Ghana Cedis (GH5.00)** into the Commission's Bank Account and take the deposit slip to the district office of the Commission where they registered for spot printing and collection of the new ID cards. The fee may be paid at any branch of GCB Bank nationwide.
